Donations of new or gently used items provide clients with needed furniture, houseware items, linens, clothing and more...

We currently are accepting the following items in good, working condition, clean and mostly free of stains and tears.

Furniture: Dressers/chests, sofas (no oversized or sleeper), Futons, Upholstered chairs, end tables, small TV stands, table lamps, kitchen table/chairs

Mattresses/Box Springs: Sizes Twin, Full or Queen (No king-size please) Bed frames (no headboards unless frame not stand alone style)

Linens: Sheets, blankets, (please indicate size on donation) (No kings please). Kitchen towels, pot holders, placemats, bath towels.

Housewares: Table lamps, dishes (plates, cups, bowls etc); serving plates/dishes; pots/pans; drinkware, bakeware; pyrex-style casserole dishes; cutlery; serving utensils; cutting knives; left-over containers (Tupperware); small appliances (coffee pots/toasters etc); cutting boards, measuring cups, colanders, etc.

Miscellaneous: flat screen TV, new digital antenna, fans, heaters, air conditioners (all in working order), foldable laundry baskets, wheeled plastic storage units, buckets/mops/brooms/vacuums, bikes ride ready

Small appliances must be clean and in working condition.

Refrigerators/freezers and washer/dryer must be clean and working.

We accept a lot of things, but here is a list of items we cannot take:

No pictures, decorations, Knick-Knacks, suitcases, books/CDs/DVDs/cassettes, sporting goods, pianos/organs, large entertainment systems, sewing machines in cabinets, large desks, hospital bed/craftmatic beds, exercise equipment, building/construction materials, electronics...(printers, computers, old style TV)
