#### Tackling Poverty Together

**Community Place on Washington** - a centralized location where organizations can more easily and efficiently share resources and community members can access or be referred to a variety of services such as emergency food and shelter, high-quality child care, counseling services, and career services. The hub is educating individual community members on **empowering one another to overcome generational poverty**.

### HOW WE'RE SUCCEEDING

**1,010** Winter Shelter beds provided from December 2017 until March 2018

**91%** of children who attended high-quality pre-k in the elizabethtown area are screened kindergarten-ready

**4,841** clients served by HUB partners in the first six months of 2018
